BASIC FUNCTION

Responsible for creating and documenting manufacturing processes. Drive lean and 6 sigma methodologies. Conduct Kaizen events.

PRIMARY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Performing inspection of incoming and fabricated parts and components to ensure compliance to specifications and standards.
- Performs in process inspections for fabrication, machining and machine assembly processes
- Uses purchase orders, engineering prints, drawings or inspection instructions, and checklists to verify conformance.
- Selects appropriate tools and instruments to measures and evaluate critical dimensions to verify conformance with established specifications and standards.
- Visually inspects parts and components for cosmetic defects or damage.
- Ensures proper completion and accuracy of production and inspection documentation.
- Reports any nonconforming conditions to the appropriate functional area personnel for disposition.
- Researches nonconformance issues to determine root cause and corrective action.

SPECIFIC CHARACTERISTICS, SKILLS AND ABILITIES REQUIRED:

- Ability to exercise good communication, organization and time management skills in a changing work environment to get the job done properly, timely and efficiently.
- Uses experience and common sense to determine proper measuring techniques and tools.
- Demonstrates a positive team spirit in daily activities.
- Exhibits zero tolerance for repeated errors and quality of work.
- A customer-focused, "how may I serve you" attitude, with timely follow-up is required.
- Ability to present technical information in a positive and understandable manner.
- Demonstrate a professional demeanor.
- Must strive for continuous improvement and excellence, both technically and interpersonally.
- As a self-starter, must possess the ability to be resourceful, work independently, where appropriate, and recognize when higher intervention may be necessary.
- Ability to work overtime as required to meet customer needs.
